

2025 Facility Use Policy



God wants The Ladder building and its activities to reflect and represent Him. As good stewards of what God has given us, we want to provide use of The Ladder space for people who are **invested** in this Christian community center. To be clear, only those invested in The Ladder are eligible to reserve the facility for an event.

The following people are **invested** in The Ladder:

- **Adult Members** *a member for at least six months and 21 visits with investment fees paid*
- **Volunteers**
- **Ladder Helpers**
- **Community Helpers**
- **Prayer Team Members** *a current prayer team member*
- **Contributors** *a person who has donated in the last two years*
- **Staff Members**

We want to provide an opportunity for Kids Hope and The Ladder youths' families to use The Ladder. For these two groups to use the facility, a staff member needs to sign out the building (complete the Facility Use Agreement) and be present during the event.

- **Youth Members** *a member for at least six months and 21 visits*
- **Kids Hope Student** *a Kids Hope student for at least six months*

An Event Supervisor will be at each event.

If you qualify per the information listed above, please call The Ladder about using the facility for your event.

Rules

Show respect and consideration to all.

Please refrain from swearing, putting down others, teasing, bullying and confronting others.

We expect all equipment and property be treated with respect and care. All equipment should be in the same condition upon leaving TLCC.

For safety of all, guns, knives and other items used as weapons are not allowed.

Smoking, vaping, and gambling are prohibited on TLCC property.

Guests must not be under the influence of, be in possession of, supply others with, or consume any drug or alcoholic beverage while on TLCC property. No Drugs and Alcohol are allowed indoor or outdoor on Ladder property. If TLCC has any reasonable basis to believe that this rule is being violated, the person will be asked to leave TLCC premises. If the person does not comply or is driving a car, police will be contacted.

If you bring personal property into TLCC, please secure and care for your property. TLCC is not responsible for loss, damage, or theft of any person's personal property.

Public displays of affection are prohibited.

Dress Code

The following styles or manners of dress are prohibited:

- Exposed bras and underwear
- Clothing and/or paraphernalia that may appear to be gang-related
- Pants or cut-offs with holes in the groin area
- Clothing with messages that advertise drugs, alcohol, tobacco, smoking, gambling, inappropriate language, demeaning remarks, sex, promotes violence, or other illicit behaviors. (Some messages on clothing have multiple meanings)
- Clothing that is immodest, unsanitary, or deviates from the accepted standards of a casual public setting
